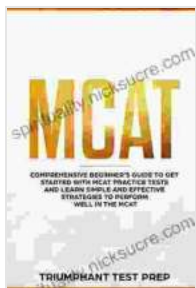

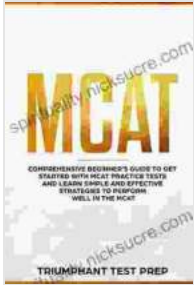

Correct Answer: B

Explanation:
A very low acid dissociation constant K_a means that the acid is weak and thus very little product is made. Since pK_a is $-\log K_a$, the negative sign means they are always opposites. Thus low K_a means high pK_a .

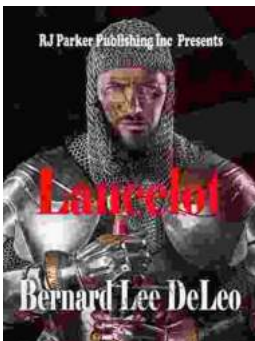

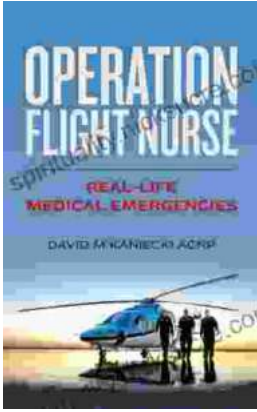
