- Unfold the paper and fold it in half along the two lines that create the "+" shape in the centre.
- Unfold the paper and fold it in half along the two lines that create the "T" shape in the centre.


- Unfold the paper and fold it in half along the two lines that create the "L" shape in the centre.
- Unfold the paper and fold it in half along the two lines that create the "R" shape in the centre.
- 12. Unfold the paper and fold it in half along the two lines that create the "S" shape in the centre.
- 13. Unfold the paper and fold it in half along the two lines that create the "D" shape in the centre.
- 14. Unfold the paper and fold it in half along the two lines that create the "F" shape in the centre.
- 15. Unfold the paper and fold it in half along the two lines that create the "G" shape in the centre.
- 16. Unfold the paper and fold it in half along the two lines that create the "H" shape in the centre.
- 17. Unfold the paper and fold it in half along the two lines


