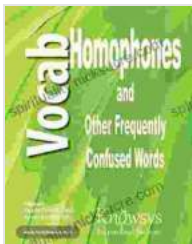
Instructions

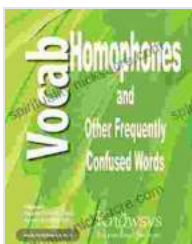

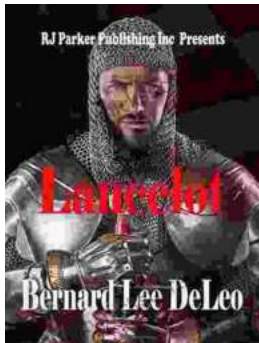

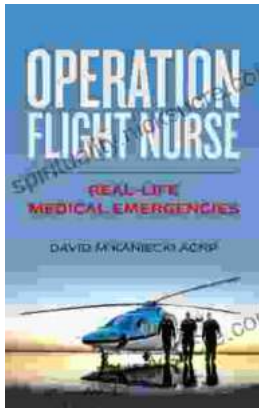
