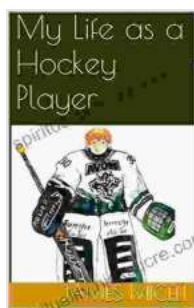


# My Life as a Hockey Player: A Journey of Passion, Perseverance, and Triumph

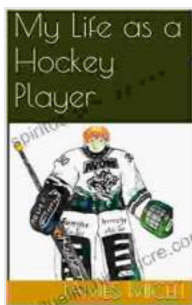

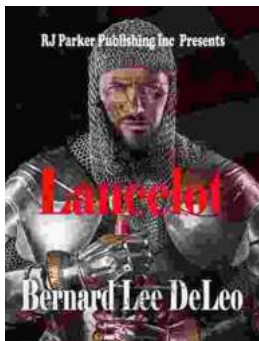

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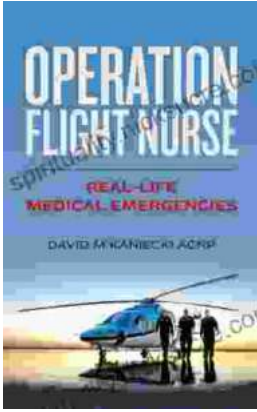
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
