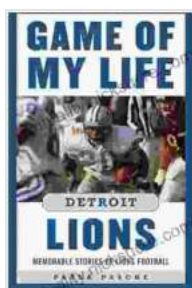


# The Game of My Life: A Detroit Lions Tale

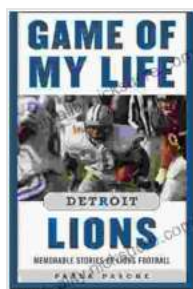

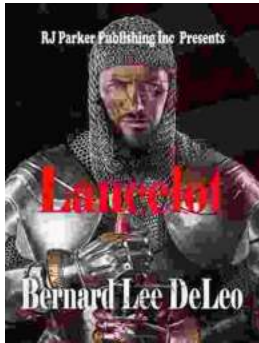

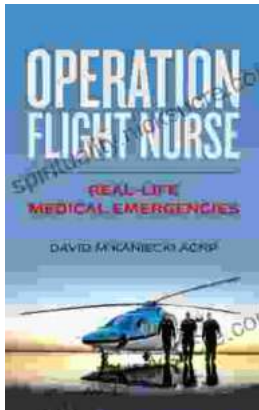
