
Why We Ignore the Obvious at Our Peril



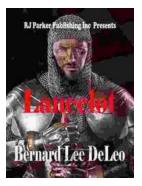

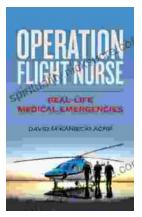
